Key components of a Gram Panchayat solid waste management strategy:

• Waste segregation at source:

• Educate households to separate biodegradable (kitchen waste) from non-biodegradable waste (plastics, glass, metal) using separate bins.

• Collection system:

- Establish door to door collection with proper separate bins for different waste types.
- Utilize a dedicated waste collection team.

Composting:

• Set up composting pits or units at the village level to treat organic waste, producing valuable manure for agriculture.

Recycling and reuse:

- Facilitate collection and recycling of recyclable materials like plastic, paper, and glass.
- Promote reuse practices through awareness campaigns.

Safe disposal:

• Identify and designate appropriate sites for the disposal of non-biodegradable waste, adhering to environmental regulations.

• Community engagement:

- Conduct regular awareness campaigns on waste management practices, including the importance of segregation and responsible disposal.
- Involve local Self Help Groups (SHGs) in waste collection and management activities.

• Capacity building:

• Train Gram Panchayat staff and waste collection workers on proper solid waste management techniques.
